Paul C. Wade, PE is a licensed professional engineer with nearly 42 years of experience in the industry. He is experienced in design, project management, inspection, and construction management of civil engineering projects.

Mr. Wade earned his Bachelor of Science degree in Civil Engineering in 1973 from Michigan Technological University. He then spent eight years working for contractors (four years as a construction superintendent) and four years as a consultant working in the areas of bridge and road design and construction engineering.

Paul began his career with Spalding DeDecker Associates, Inc. (SDA), a civil engineering and surveying firm, in 1985 as a Project Manager. During his almost 30-year tenure, Paul achieved progressive professional growth advancing to Vice President, and subsequently Sr. Vice President. His responsibilities included the development and implementation of short- and long-term initiatives to ensure profitability and growth for the firm.
