

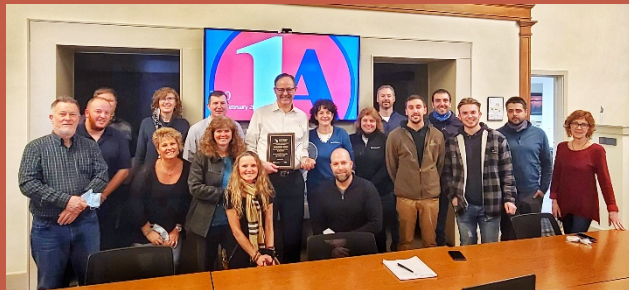


## 2022 ACEC/M MEMBER FIRM OF THE YEAR AWARD

## JUDGING CRITERIA



### 1. The member firm has contributed to the success and growth of ACEC/M during the past 2 years by one or more representatives from the firm:

- Serving as an ACEC/M Director
- Actively participating on committee(s)
- Recruitment of a new ACEC/M member firm
- Working with a new member/developing firm as a mentor
- Functioning as a liaison between ACEC/M and another organization
- Sponsoring an ACEC/M event
- Participating in the state and federal political process in support of ACEC/M objectives
- Other related activities



### 2. The member firm has advanced the consulting design profession during the past 2 years through:

- Publishing an article on an issue of importance to ACEC/M or speaking to a professional or non-professional group
- Entering a project in the ACEC/M Engineering & Surveying Excellence Awards Competition
- Supporting the ACEC/M scholarship program
- Achieving an industry quality designation, governmental certification or association certificate
- Contributing to ACEC National and ACEC/M Political Action Committees
- Actions that have led to improved management of the firm, such as enrolling an employee in the ACEC/M Emerging Leaders Program
- Other related activities



### 3. The member firm has been active in community involvement during the past 2 years by:

- Encouraging staff to become active in the local community
- Identifying and promoting opportunities for staff to assist people (young and old) in becoming acquainted with the engineering profession
- Sponsoring a program such as Adopt-A-Highway, Habitat for Humanity, Toys for Tots, United Way, or similar activity that benefits a community
- Other related activities
